

## **Come Quilt With Us!**

Our Quilting Retreats are designed to allow you to connect with others who share this same passion and faith. The schedule is relaxed to allow participants to get to know each other and share their quilting projects with one another.

We pepper the schedule with devotionals connecting quilting and your relationship with God. Together we explore how quilting fits into the fabric of our lives and what parallels we can draw from the quilting process.

Informal mini lectures are held throughout the retreats, in which different quilting techniques and designs are taught. Bring your current quilting project or start a new one during the retreat. Beginners are Welcome! If you have never quilted before Lorraine Mooney will be on hand to help you get started into the quilting world.



### **Lorraine Mooney**

In January of 2007 WCRC welcomed to its staff Lorraine Mooney who moved to Virginia from New York in 2005. Lorraine graduated from the New Paltz campus of the State University of New York with a degree in Art Education. She spent ten years teaching before “retiring” to stay home and raise her four children.

As her children grew she worked part-time teaching in a sewing and knitting store. She eventually took over the store when the owner retired. After moving to Virginia, Lorraine joined two local quilting guilds in the Williamsburg area. She has taught workshops on quilting projects in both guilds and several others including the Virginia Consortium of Quilters. Lorraine also designs and sells her own quilting patterns.

Over many years of quilting Lorraine has found quilting has helped her relate to and stay close to the Lord. She is anxious to share this relationship at the retreat.

Quilt and quilt related patterns by Lorraine will be available for sale at the retreat.

## **Lodging**

Quilters will stay in Oakwood Lodge, our motel style building. Tables and chairs will be provided in a large meeting room for quilters to use as they work. Plan to bring your own sewing machines if you use one when quilting.

## **Spring and Fall Retreats**

This weekend retreat officially goes from Friday at 4pm through Sunday at 11am. Weekend meals will be served from Dinner on Friday through Breakfast on Sunday. Weekend quilters wishing extra quilting time may arrive anytime after 9am on Friday morning and can stay as late as 4pm on Sunday. Prices are based on weekend lodging options.

Wednesday and Thursday quilters:

If you want MORE quilting time; come early to the Retreat! There is an additional fee for Wednesday and Thursday, which will include lodging and meals. Check in for Wednesday and Thursday quilters will begin at 9am on their respective dates. Wednesday quilters will be provided with meals and lodging from lunch on Wednesday through lunch on Thursday. Thursday quilters will be provided with meals and lodging from Thursday lunch through Friday lunch.
