Several years ago Gordon Miller, a pastor from Lyndhurst VA, began to send kids from his church to camp, first utilizing the WCRC scholarship fund, and then by holding an annual church fundraiser. In 2018 they sent 6 campers, and each year the number has gone up. In 2023 they sent 16 campers! Gordon says,

We are very grateful for our relationship with Williamsburg Christian Retreat Center. We know our youth are loved, cared for, and fed spiritually. This is a ministry that has helped our youth grow and has given them courage to take on a significant role during our worship times.

This fall, after attending camp for several years, one of the campers from Lyndhurst, Chloe, decided to get baptized! She said,

I have learned so much about God over the years but I definitely think camp was what got me going in the Word and being more engaged in the Bible and God. Today I start a new life and focus more on God and not the troubles of the world.
